

## Ladies Golf Apprenticeships at Scarborough North Cliff Golf Club

This initiative is aimed at recruitment of Ladies and Girls to Club membership, ensuring their integration into the Club and retention of their membership in the longer term by providing a structured and friendly environment, making it easy for them to play and be involved in all aspects of club membership

Apprentice status only available for an initial year of a new Club membership and subject to the following joining criteria and playing restrictions.

1. Application for apprentice membership will not be accepted from ladies with a current playing handicap at an EGU affiliated golf club or have previously held a handicap with any EGU affiliated club in the preceding three years.
2. Completion of Club member application form and acceptance by the Club Committee after recommendation subsequent to interview.
3. Payment of a non-refundable membership fee of £250.00
4. Agreement to undertake at least 4 lessons with the Club Professional or less if the Club Professional advises capability is sufficiently good to play the course unattended. The lessons required will be subsidized to 50% of the usual cost by the Club and the Professional.
5. The appointment of a full member or group of full members to ensure full integration into the Club and to assist in obtaining playing opportunities with other Club members, also to provide any advice on items such as rules or etiquette etc
6. Tee times will be restricted to; 1. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday, 10.00 through till 15.00 and 18.00 through till dusk 2. Saturday & Sunday 15.00 through till dusk. There will be no restriction applied on Tuesday.
7. Entry into competitions will be limited to those arranged by the Club or Ladies Section for players of 36 or higher handicap or competitions where it is allowed to handicap down to entry level and always subject to having a current playing handicap
8. Apprentice members will be allowed full access to all social events and amenities organized by the Club and are strongly encouraged to support the social calendar and thereby enjoy the full golf club experience.
9. The apprentice will be allowed and expected to take up full membership of the Club on completion of the apprentice year or at any time during the apprentice year, subject to having obtained a playing handicap, on payment of the appropriate pro rata fee.
10. Apprentice lady members will in all other respects be expected to abide by the Club rules and bye laws
